Jacob raised sheep and goats and cattle, which kept him very busy. However Jacob had lots of help because he had 12 sons. His sons started with grown-up Reuben and ranged in age down to little baby Benjamin. Out of all these sons, Jacob had one <u>favorite</u> son that he loved more than the others. This was his 17 year old son named Joseph. Joseph was very clever, he helped his father and he loved God and tried to do what's right. One day Jacob made a very special coat for Joseph. The coat was not brown...it was not white ... and the coat wasn't even black, like many coats in that day. This coat was sewn and decorated with richly colored

threads, making it very beautiful. None of the other sons had a coat as beautiful as Joseph did and they were angry that Joseph got something they didn't have. They were <u>also</u> angry at Joseph because he kept track of them and would tell his father when they did something wrong, like cheating when they sold the sheep, or keeping money that belonged to their father. Jesus tells us that we are to: "Love your enemies,...and ... do good to those who hate you" (Matt.5:44) Can you learn this verse? Think about this verse and if you lean it, have mom or dad put a check mark here. Good job!

It would please God to try and show kindness and love even when we might feel bad because a friend has more things than we do or you think a little brother or sister gets better treatment, and we do want to please God, don't we?

- 13. Which brother planned on rescuing Joseph? (A) Reuben (B) Simeon (C) Benjamin


